- ART

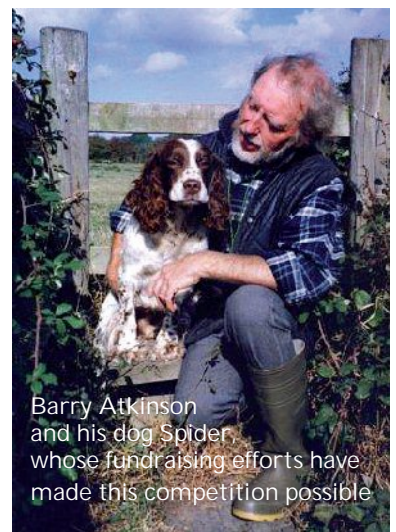
We will design, build and plant a bespoke 'wildlife conservation garden' at the school whose entry is judged to be the best overall.
